We will be showing the short, BAFTA nominated, docu-film 'Visible Mending' by Samantha Moore.

Hot drinks and refreshments will be on offer and the chance to knit your own 'paper chain' too! The knitted/crocheted chain will be used as a way-marker for the Longest Yarn 2 in Tean – showing people the way to Great Wood Hall from the village car park! Wool, needles and pattern supplied - or bring your own (wool and needles). No need to book, no obligation to knit/crochet, just turn up and enjoy the time together.

Knitted/crocheted 'paper' chains

We are celebrating The Longest Yarn 2 coming to Tean during December 2025 by knitting/crocheting a chain, please join in so we can display the chain in Tean along with the exhibition.

For Knitting: cast on 12/14 stitches and garter stitch until 50 cms using 4mm needles
OR 55 stitches for 25cm width and knit for 12cm. Then the "long" fold will be along the line of the garter stitch.

For Crochet: 45 on a 4mm hook



Then use mesh to strengthen and sew together to make the chain.
Outside is providing the mesh – available from Wellspring Cheadle and Tean – and hoping that you can find bits of wool to use within the community.

Knitting get-togethers are happening at Wellspring Cheadle, Chapel Street, ST10 1DY in November, all welcome, come with or without wool 😊

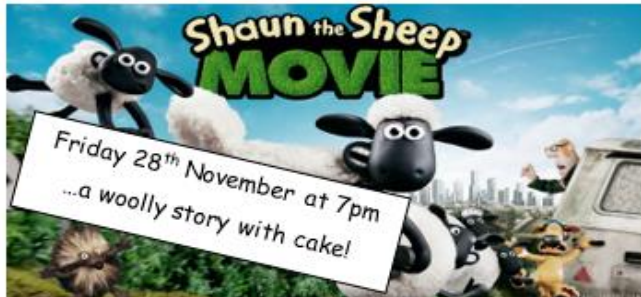

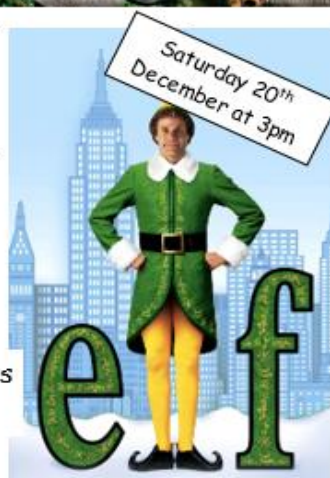
